- 3. The residence shown on Schedule "A" was originally a cheese factory that was converted to a residence prior to the purchase by the Foley family in 1961. The well that was used originally at the cheese factory and subsequently has serviced the residence was a well that was located on what is now my property to the east and which is located approximately 40 feet from the east lot line of the lands shown on Schedule "A".
